


Prestwick Centre

NATS operates two air traffic control centres in the UK. One at Swanwick in Hampshire and the other in Prestwick, Ayrshire.

Prestwick Centre handles air traffic across northern England, Scotland and out into North East Atlantic.

The Centre is continuously operational 24x7x365.





two premier league football pitches and larger than forty tennis courts.


