Changes to London Luton Airport arrival flight paths



Why do we need to change the airspace?

Currently London Luton Airport (LLA) shares arrival and holding areas with Stansted Airport, which makes the airspace for arrivals complex for Air Traffic Control.

This Airspace Change Proposal (ACP) aims to improve safety and reduce the delay for arriving aircraft.

This proposal would provide LLA with new arrival routes to a new holding area, and new routes from the holding area to the runway.

The ACP is co-sponsored by LLA and NATS, with LLA primarily responsible for route design below 7,000ft, and NATS for the design above.
